The Michigan Flywheelers Museum will host its Antique Engine and Tractor Show Thursday, Sept. 10 through Sunday, Sept. 13, 2026 at the museum located at 06285 68th St., South Haven, MI

PRE-REGISTRATION

Registration/Payment must be received BEFORE July 1st.

Regular Lot - \$55
Center Walkway Corner Lot - \$60
Main Road Corner Lot- \$65

LATE REGISTRATION

These prices are effective if you register AFTER July 1st.

Regular Lot - \$75
Center Walkway Corner Lot - \$80
Main Road Corner Lot \$85

Prices are good for all four days of the show. Last year's vendors have first dibs on their lots if they register by July 1. Any remaining lots are filled on a first come basis. Lot sizes are 23 feet deep by 25 feet in length.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Flea Market Registration Office will open Tuesday, Sept. 8 and Wednesday, Sept. 9 from 8:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. ONLY.

You need to register/check in during these times. YOU CAN NOT SET UP ONCE THE SHOW STARTS. After you check in, you will be shown to your lot. You need to be set up and ready to sell when the show opens at 8 a.m. Thursday. This is an outdoor flea market and no electric is available. The show ends on Sunday at 4 p.m. DO NOT TEAR DOWN BEFORE THAT TIME. There is a \$100 drawing at 4 p.m. Sunday. You have to be present at the office with ID before 4 p.m. to win.

VEHICLES will not be allowed into the showgrounds from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. You are welcome to park in the parking lot and walk in during these times. Seller are allowed only one vehicle inside the show once it starts. A vehicle permit will be issued during set up hours. Vehicles must be parked on your lot if there is room. Extra vehicles can park in the parking lot.

CAMPING is allowed on your lot. If you don't have room, additional camp sites are available and cost \$20 per night.

QUIET TIME is midnight to 7 a.m. This means no running generators, barking dogs etc.

ALCOHOL/CANNABIS is allowed at campsites only. You can not walk around, enter buildings, drive equipment with either.

WRISTBANDS must be worn at all times or you will be charged admission. Vendors receive two free wristbands. Additional ones cost \$10 and are good for all four days.

PETS are allowed with vendors. They must be leashed or kenneled and stay on your lot at all times. Owners are responsible for their pets and must clean up after them.

PERSONAL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES (PTV): Any machinery that has a motor and is not considered a mobility unit (one seater) has to be registered. Registration fee is \$30 and good for all four days. ATVs, mini-bikes and dirt bikes are not allowed.

ITEMS THAT CAN NOT BE SOLD include firearms, weapons, fireworks, concession-type foods. such as hot dogs, popcorn, chips, Michigan Flywheelers Museum logo items, Black River Railroad logo items and pornographic material. ATVs, mini-bikes and dirt bikes can be sold, but not driven around the property. **Absolutely NO political items including Confederate or vulgar language items can be sold. This is a family show - not a political rally.**

TRASH - Please clean up your lot. Do not leave tires, equipment, broken furniture etc. Take them with you. Please take all trash to dumpsters that are located on South Road and Flywheeler Drive.

FLEA MARKET MANAGER reserves the right to determine if vendors are not following the rules and need to be asked to leave or banned.
